Sara Valaguzza is Full Professor at the University of Milan and the founding president of the European Association of Public Private Partnership. She is also the director of the Italian Centre of Construction Law & Management, constituted by the University of Milan, the Polytechnic of Milan and the University of Brescia.

She is serving in the University of Milan Foundation as a member of the board of directors.

She is involved in several public private partnership initiatives advising public authorities and local governments and piloting case studies for improving public value.

Professor Valaguzza is a leading expert on administrative and environmental law.

She has written six monographs, both in Italian and in English, and more than 50 essays on administrative law topics. She has written extensively on institutional design, public procurement, administrative procedure, European multilevel governance, sustainable development, *res iudicata* and judicial review.

Her books *Alliancing in public sector* (2019) and *Governing by contract – Procuring for Value* (2018), are recognized by the academic community as a deep analysis of the fragmented situation of public organizations and a starting point for reforming frameworks and tools for outsourcing. Recently, as one of the first European scholars expert on collaborative behaviours in public sector, she authored a chapter in the book *Collaborative Construction Procurement*, by David Mosey (2019), about the civil law countries' approach to alliancing and collaborative procurement.

She also practices as attorney for Italian and international clients and leads a research group to promote collaborative procurement in public and private sector, reaching environmental and social targets and producing added value.

She is a founding member of the Transnational Alliancing Group, an international group of academics and practitioners constituted in 2018 for the research and dissemination of collaborative frameworks all around the world.

Eduardo Parisi is Postdoctoral Research Fellow in Administrative Law at the University of Milan where he carries out a research project on alliancing and collaborative behaviours in contractual relationships.

During his PhD on Administrative Law (University of Milan – 2014–2017) he deepened the subject of co-administration among public institutions at the European level.

He holds an LLM in Legal Theory – NYU School of Law. His research focus was on environmental law and global administrative law.

He is the Responsible for the International Relationships of the European Association of Public Private Partnership and contributes to the initiatives of the network lecturing at international conferences on the issues of public private partnership.

As a founding member of the Transnational Alliancing Group, he is working with several academics and professionals on construction procurements in a global perspective.

As an attorney at law, he worked with numerous public administrations, on projects of public procurement and public private partnership.
