

# Preface

This book reports the results of a survey of students at global European graduate programs in economics and interviews at six of them. European economics is especially interesting at this time because of the changes that are currently going on there in response to the EU's Common Educational Policy. The book provides students' views of the ongoing changes and the difficulties these changes entail. It consists of an introductory chapter and a chapter summarizing the survey results and explaining the changes going on, three chapters reporting the qualitative survey results, six chapters of interviews with the students, and a final chapter drawing broader policy implications from the study.
