* The ‘Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus’ (TRNC) is a self-proclaimed unrecognised entity whose unilateral declaration of independence on 15 November 1983 was censured as a ‘secession of part of the Republic of Cyprus’, considered ‘legally invalid’, and

'call[ed] for its withdrawal' by the UN Security Council in Resolution 541, *Cyprus, S/RES/541* (18 November 1983), accessed 20 June 2018 at [www.un.org/en/ga/search/view_doc.asp?symbol=S/RES/541\(1983\)](http://www.un.org/en/ga/search/view_doc.asp?symbol=S/RES/541(1983)). Furthermore, the EU describes the territory under the TRNC as 'areas of the Republic of Cyprus in which the Government of the Republic of Cyprus does not exercise effective control' and upon which 'the Community and Union acquis [is] suspended'.
